1. **Call to Order:** Aubrey Called the Meeting to Order.

2. **Welcome and Approval of Minutes:** We don't have minutes to approve.

3. **Review of Parent Suggestions/Complaints:** No suggestions. Suzi did talk about the Governor's decision to drop the mask mandate the last week of school. The school will not be requiring masks but all other safety procedures will be in place.

4. **School Land Trust Review:** Suzi shared the school land trust. All goals are the same except for one. Tutors & Literacy- RISE scores are remaining same. This is good to see especially due to the challenges of this year. Middle School we saw an 8% improvement on those who targeted tutor. 1st goal- Dia will reward students with math and learning arts. We have \$1000 set aside. #2 3rd-8th overall score RISE by 10% using tutors/par \$38,000 #3- Improve mathematics k-5, Bridges and Mathematics professional development (2 trainings \$5000 per training) 4 new training. #4- Mini Grants \$9350. 5. **Teacher Mini-Grants:** 5th grade- asking for equipment for science experiments plus dictionaries for a total of \$300. 1st grade- Sanchez- request for professional development course. The course will help develop her dual immersion teaching \$480. Kinder- Astorga, professional development \$449 to help work with students with behavior disorders. Astorga- manipulatives for Spanish and English centers. Dynamic ways to respond for both Math & Alphabet \$374.05. Estafina- Add to books in the library, nonfiction, books related to common core social studies 7 sets/35 books \$1004. Purchase of student of the month medals- 140 medals to recognize preschool-8th grade. It was in the \$300
