1. Call to Order: Erin Called the Meeting to Order.

2. Welcome and Approval of Minutes: Erin reviewed minutes from the November meetings. Aubrey motioned to accept the minutes and Jennifer seconded the motion.

3. **Review of Parent Suggestions/Complaints:** There was a parent who is concerned that the students do not have access to the library. Pre-COVID specials use to be each one every week after COVID it was changed to a block situation to decreases the exposure. This was kept for many different reasons. The parent was concerned that their student couldn't access the library outside of their rotation. Suzi addressed this with the parent and students are able to access the library at anytime.

Another parent brought up the fact that it appeared the middle school students had the ability to create a google classroom of their own. This has been resolved on an admin level. Only approved DIA teachers will be able to create classrooms.

4. School Safety and Digital Citizenship: The Council watched the video on Digital Citizenshipthe video talked about The Council and the school's responsibility when it comes to our students' digital citizenship. The video also introduced us to UEN, this organization provides a lot of different opportunities to cover this. They offer free classes.

The school uses H-Wire. We have a tech on site 2 days a week and available anytime. The school uses Eyeboss to restrict access to websites. Youtube is blocked. They do use Go

Guardian that allows the teachers to lock students into a website, so they can't go somewhere else.

The school has policies in place that if students not follow it can lead to a Tech suspension.

5. School Land Trust Budget Review: Mini-grants 8200 for Dreambox 10,000 for training (only used 3,000) 3,800 set aside for aides- that has been used. Left over of just under 9,000 We can only carry over 10%... Ideas that we could use the extra funding for: Summer Program Aide to help with Kindergarten

6. School Positive Behavior Plan: Not discussed.

7. Review of Mini Grant- The council reviewed and approved a mini grant for Ms Barceguin. She requested \$408 for material that will help with Phonemic Awareness, Math and general classroom teaching aides.
