1. **Welcome and Approval of Minutes:** Aubrey called the meeting to order. The council reviewed the minutes from the emergency session. Erin motioned to approve the minutes, Jennifer seconded the motion. The minutes were approved.
2. **Review of Parent Suggestions/Complaints:** There have been complaints about the dismissal process from an outside source. We talked about different ways to improve the flow of traffic. The closing of the parking lot across the street has had a negative impact on dismissal process. The council will think on ways to help improve the situation, but maybe opening up a volunteer opportunity would help.
3. **Digital Safety and Citizenship:** The council reviewed the curriculum used to teach digital citizenship to the students. It was called Common Sense and it broke things down into units specific to each grade. This was incorporated into the classroom and it was quick and progressive. For the younger grades it was 10-15-minute-long units middle school units were 30-40 minutes. We still need to add the parent component to digital citizenship. The council is looking at implementing a parent education component before spring break, either the week of March 16<sup>th</sup> or March 23<sup>rd</sup>.
4. **DIA's Positive Behavior Plan PBIS-** DIA has a positive behavior plan that contains three tiers. Tier 1 is everyone, Tier 2 is a student that struggles a little and Tier 3 is a student that struggles a lot. There are also different methods that teachers and staff use to influence the behavior in positive ways, DOJO points, trackers and having a staff assigned to a student to help and assist with the plan and behavior. Teachers also implement individualized actions within the classroom.

Erin motioned to adjourn the meeting and Aubrey seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned.
